If you haven't already been introduced to the world of Fieldey, get ready for a new style of genre-breaking art that's cheeky, anti-establishment, raw, colourful and of course would look fabulous on the wall of your home or office or in a man cave.

It's free to look (or just wonder at what this gal dreams about at night!) and all works are for sale through MuKau Gallery. The boards will be on exhibition from March 15 – 24.
